KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE

It is important to show respect for your child's privacy; however, if you have concerns for their safety or well-being, you have the right to take action.



Set and enforce rules and consequences.



Monitor, track, and limit the use of the computer, phones, and other electronic devices.



Call law enforcement if your child is engaging in illegal or harmful behaviors.



Know your child's friends and their friends' parents.



Search your child's room, vehicle, or other personal space.



Administer a drug test.



Know your child's whereabouts; who they are with and what they are doing.



Read your child's diary.



Schedule a drug/alcohol evaluation.
