

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS LSD

Street Names

Acid, Blotter, Boomers, Cubes, Microdot, Yellow sunshines, Ying yang, Paper acid, Superman

Method of Use

Orally (absorbed into "blotter papers" and is dissolved on the tongue and other tissues within the mouth)



Symptoms/ Effects of Use

- Dilated pupils
- Disorientation
- Rambling or strange speech
- Sweating
- Dry mouth
- Rapid mood changes
- Erratic, unpredictable behavior
- Sleeplessness
- Loss of appetite
- Panic and/or heightened anxiety response
- Increased body temperature
- Increased heart rate
- Increased blood pressure
- Tremors
- Flashbacks (even long after use of the drug has ended)
- Altered sense of self and time
- Hearing colors and seeing sounds ("cross-over" sensations)
- Delusions/visual hallucinations



What to look for...

- Rapid mood swings
- Anxiety/paranoia
- Sweating
- Change in speech
- Dilated pupils
- Drastic change in sensations/feelings
- Papers with stamp-like pictures
