

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS DEXTROMETHORPHAN

Street Names

Robotripping, Robo, Triple C's (Coricidin)

Method of Use

Orally (in tablet, gel cap, or liquid form)

Pain Medications

Dextromethorphan (DXM) is the active ingredient found in over-the-counter (OTC) cough/cold medications such as Robitussin, Vicks, Coricidin, and Mucinex.

Not all types of cough/cold medications contain DXM, it will be identified on the label.

Symptoms/ Effects of Use

- Numbness
- Nausea/vomiting
- In high doses it can produce dissociative or out-of-body experiences or hallucinations (similar to PCP/ketamine)
- Increased heart rate
- Increased blood pressure
- Impaired motor function

What to look for...

- Hidden, empty bottles/packages of cold medication
- Mood swings
- Erratic behavior
- Hallucinations
