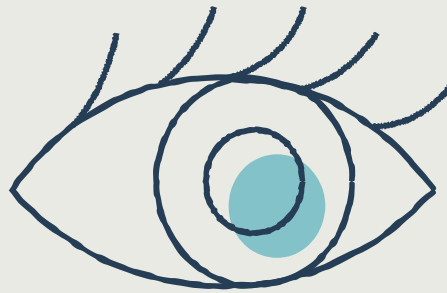

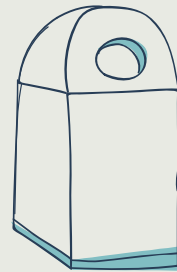
Lock

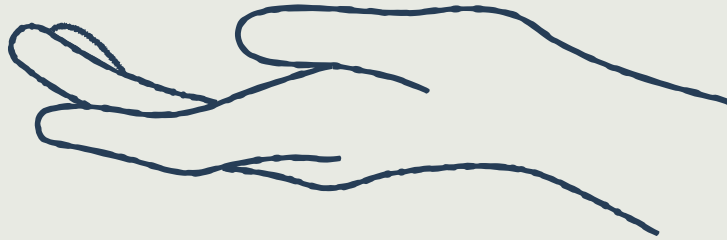
