Be responsible with your medication.

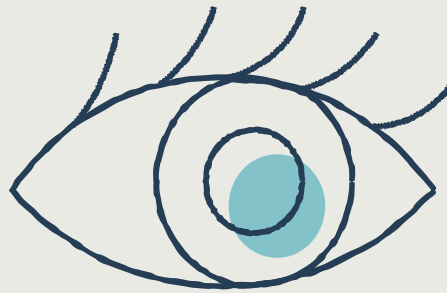

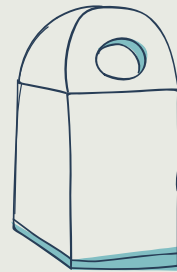
## Lock

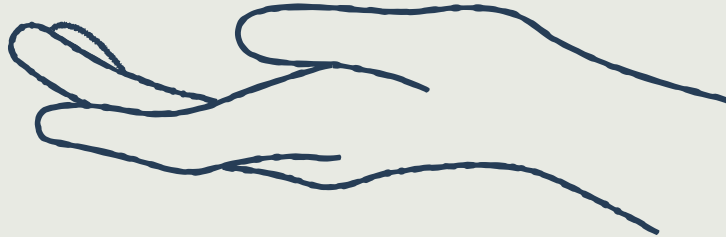
