

- Face is clammy to touch and has lost color. Vomiting or gurgling noises.
- Body is limp. Fingernails or lips have a blue or purple tinge.
- **Sleep** is deep and cannot be awakened. Difficulty speaking.
- Breathing is slow or has stopped.
- Heartbeat is slow or has stopped.
