

# Attorney General Take Back Program Comparison

North Dakota offers two free locations for residents to dispose of unused or unwanted medications, including controlled substances – participating law enforcement agencies and participating MedSafe program pharmacies.\*

All Take Back locations able to collect controlled substances are currently listed on the [North Dakota Office of the Attorney General website](#).

## PROGRAM GOALS:

**1** Provide access to a secure and safe way to dispose of over-the-counter and prescription medication, including controlled substances.

**2** Provide a mechanism to reduce the amount of medications in a person's home to assure they are not diverted or misused.



### Law Enforcement Agencies

- Regulated by the ND Office of the Attorney General.
- North Dakota law enforcement agencies interested in offering this service must contact the ND Office of the Attorney General.



### Pharmacies

- Regulated by the ND Board of Pharmacy and MedSafe program.
- North Dakota pharmacies interested in offering this service must contact the ND Board of Pharmacy.
- \*Only pharmacies participating in the MedSafe program can collect controlled substances.
- \*Only pharmacies participating in the MedSafe program are listed on the ND Office of the Attorney General's website.
