Spotlight on Effective Prevention What are COMPLIANCE CHECKS?

Compliance checks are a type of environmental prevention strategy that deters alcohol outlets from selling alcohol to underage youth. Law enforcement officials supervise undercover youth who attempt to purchase alcohol; if the attempt is successful, the establishment is penalized. Compliance checks are thought to be most effective when they are frequent, well publicized, and well designed; solicit community support; and impose penalties on the licensed establishment rather than just the server.

By decreasing alcohol availability, compliance checks are believed to also reduce alcohol-related problems and crime among youth.

Funding Opportunities

School Climate Transformation Grant [LEA]

Provides funds to local educational agencies to increase their capacity to help schools in communities with pervasive violence.

Providing funds for local and state educational authorities interested in testing initiatives that enhance school safety.
